ABOUT THE ENSEMBLE

Iowa Percussion and the Iowa Steel Band began their relationship with Arts Share in 1997. That year they became one of four groups from the Arts Share roster to tour Iowa with support from a "US West Interact with the Arts" grant. In 1997 and again in 1998, Iowa Percussion presented "Making Music Field Trip" concerts on the campus of the University of Iowa which became the model for our on-campus outreach concerts.

In 1999 Iowa Percussion/Iowa Steel Band presented the first of many "Target Family Concerts" that were sponsored by Arts Share and the retail store Target. These concerts were performed by several different School of Music ensembles over the years. We presented Target concerts off and on until 2007 when the Target funding ended.

Arts Share Program Director, Leslie Finer took over leadership in 2003 and over the

course of the next few years rebranded the program the “Arts Share Community Concert.”

Iowa Percussion has been part of the Arts Share Community Concert series regularly since 2014.

In addition to on-campus concerts, Iowa Percussion and the Iowa Steel Band have toured throughout the great state of Iowa every year since 1997 under the auspices of Arts Share. They have now performed in 50 of Iowa’s 99 counties—and counting!

Arts Share coordinates more than 300 events per year, including workshops and performances, in communities across Iowa. Arts Share is committed to filling gaps in arts programming and utilizing the arts to enhance quality of life.
